

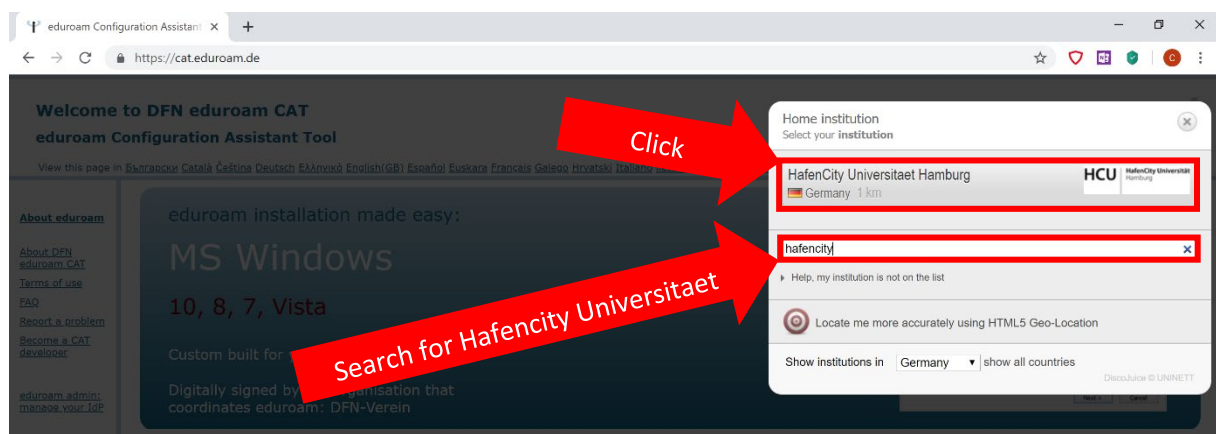
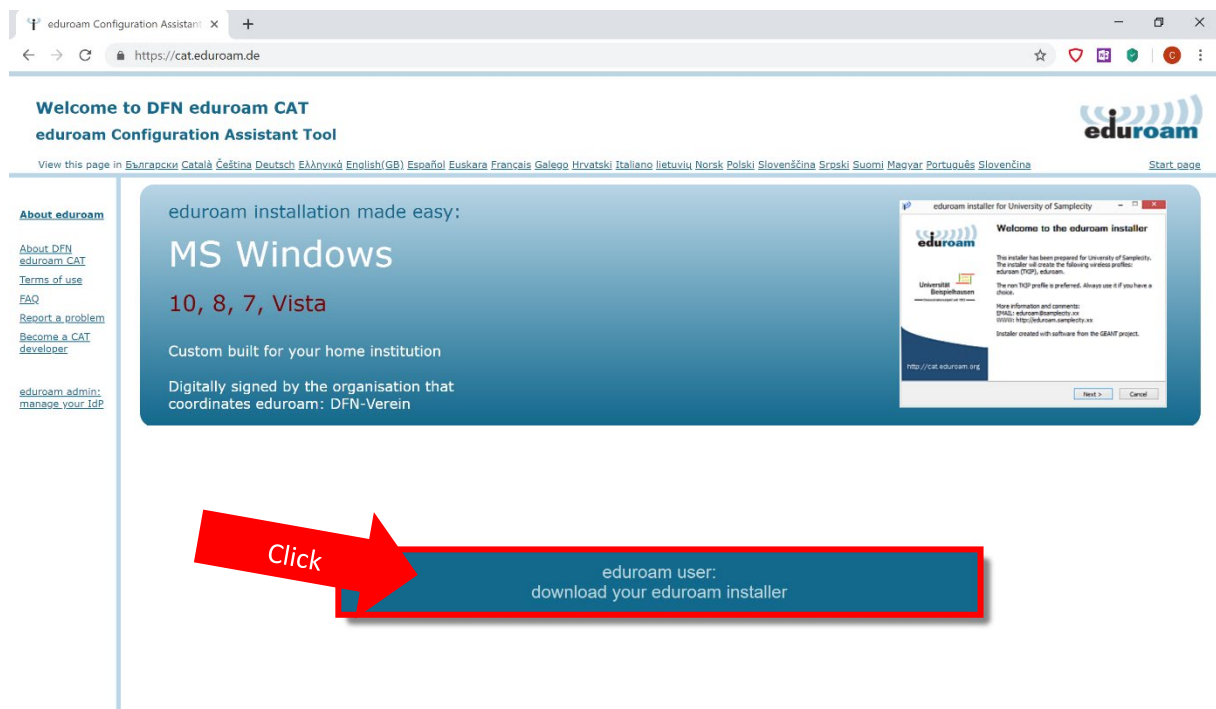
Configuring Eduroam with the „Configuration Assistant Tool“ (CAT) on Android devices

Updated March 2020

You have to be connected to the internet.

If you don't have access to the internet: Access HCU-Guest Wi-Fi network. Credentials for this Wi-Fi network are accessible from the internal part of hcu-hamburg.de.

Go to <https://cat.eduroam.org/> and switch to the English version.

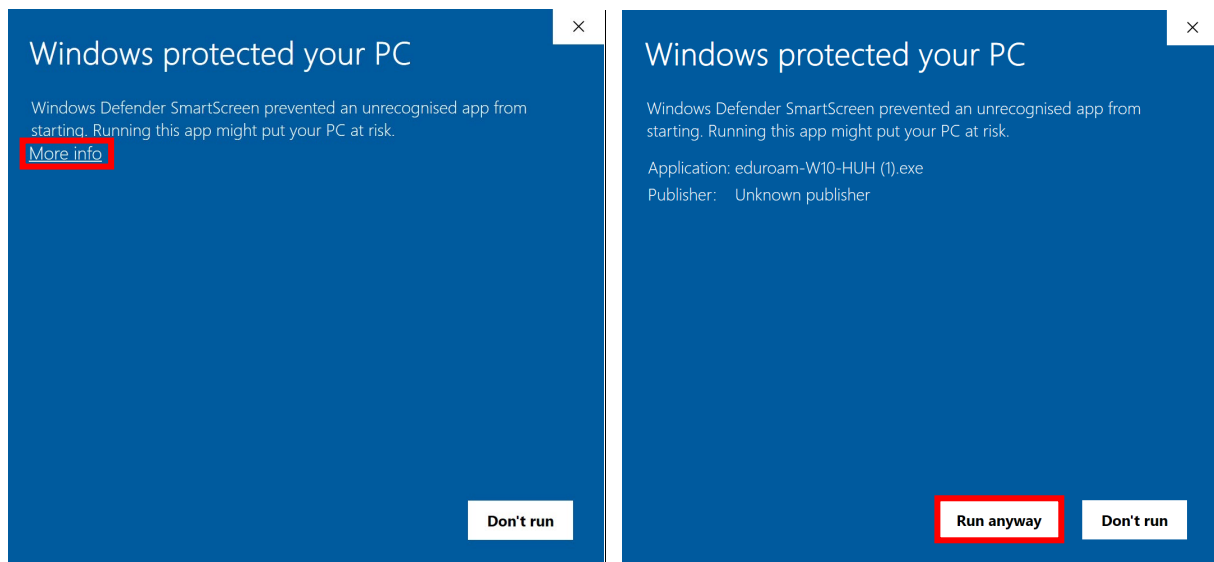


HCU-IT → Instructions for Eduroam on Windows devices



- Click the button to start the download.
- Open your explorer and head to your downloads folder.
- Open the .exe file.

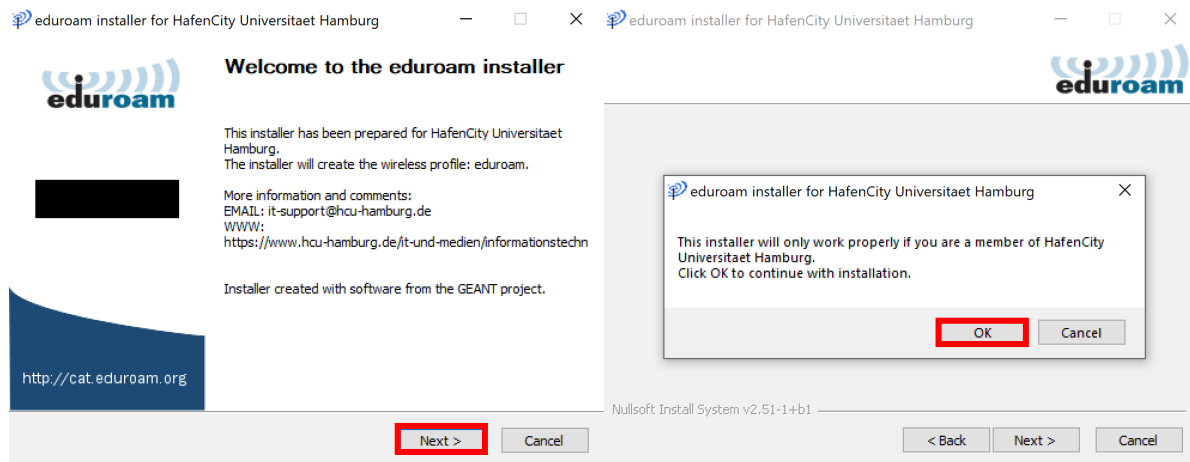
As soon as you open the file you will get a Windows warning. Just take note of this warning and run the program anyway. Otherwise you cannot install the software.



- Click „More info“.
- Click „Run anyway“.

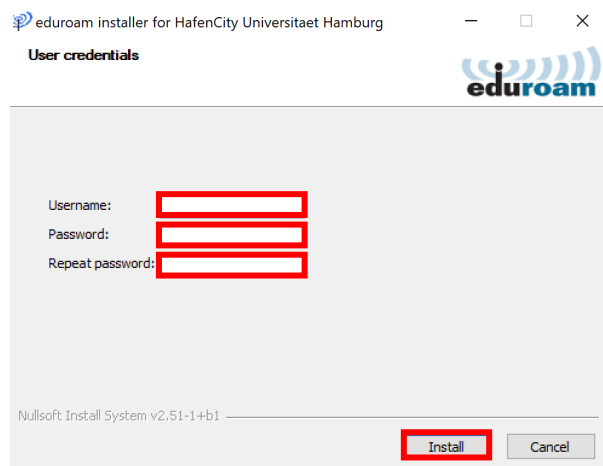
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Now the installation for the software begins.



→ Click „Next“.

→ Click „OK“.

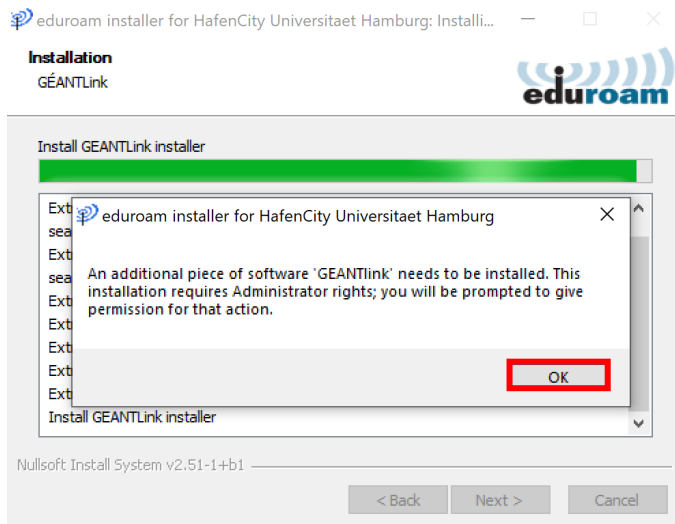


→ Enter your HCU-username and password, for example hcu123@hcu-hamburg.de.

→ Click „Install“.

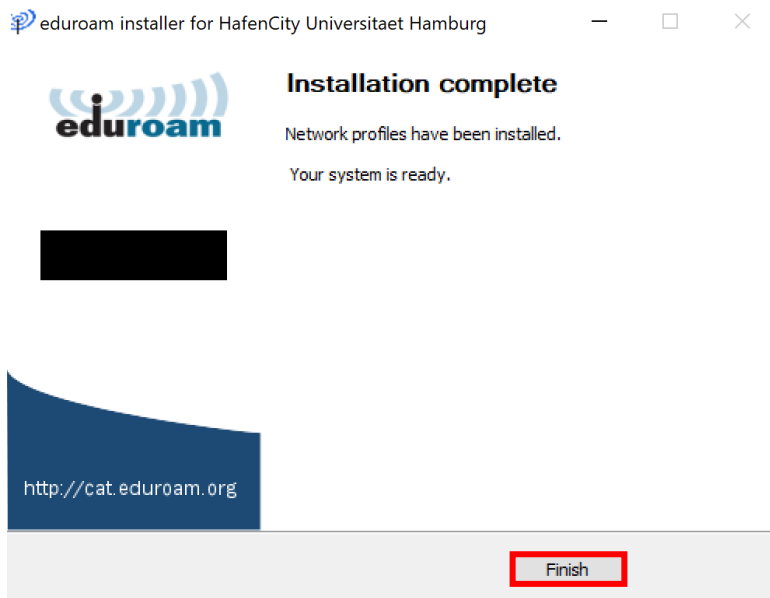
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To complete the installation an additional software is needed. GEANTlink will be automatically installed when you confirm the window with OK.



→ Click „OK“.

The installation is now complete.



→ Click „Finish“.

Your device should now automatically connect to the Eduroam Wi-Fi Network.
